Frana Ramovša, bo potekal na Slovenski akademiji znanosti in umetnosti, Inštitutu za slovenski jezik Franca Ramovša ZRC SAZU in Filozofski fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani **med 20. in 23. septembrom 2022**. Zvrstili se bodo naslednji dogodki: Ramovšev dan: mednarodno srečanje in dan Inštituta za slovenski jezik Franca Ramovša ZRC SAZU v Atriju ZRC SAZU ter Prešernovi dvorani SAZU in odprtje razstave o Franu Ramovšu na Filozofski fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani **v torek, 20. septembra 2022**; Ramovšev simpozij v Veliki dvorani SAZU 21. septembra 2022; 4. Ramovšev simpozij

Slovenska akademija znanosti in umetnosti (II. Razred za filološke in literarne vede) organizira v sredo,

21. septembra 2022, znanstveni simpozij ob 70. obletnici smrti akademika Frana Ramovša. Humanist, slovenist, primerjalni jezikoslovec, jezikovni zgodovinar, narečjeslovec, imenoslovec, urednik in univerzitetni profesor akademik Fran Ramovš se je rodil 14. septembra 1890 v Ljubljani, kjer je 16. septembra 1952 tudi umrl. Po študiju v Gradcu in na Dunaju je bil leta 1919 med soustanovitelji ljubljanske univerze – 3. decembra je imel prvo predavanje na novoustanovljeni univerzi v Ljubljani, med letoma 1934 in 1935 je bil rektor univerze – in eden izmed prvih profesorjev Filozofske fakultete, tudi njen dekan med letoma 1926 in 1927. Bil je soustanovitelj in med prvimi imenovanimi člani Akademije znanosti in umetnosti v Ljubljani (1938), kasneje pa njen glavni tajnik (1942–1950) in 4. predsednik (1950–1952). Leta 1945 je ustanovil in nato vodil Inštitut za slovenski jezik. Bil je častni član Slavističnega društva Slovenije in dopisni član več akademij znanosti. Njegovo znanstveno delo je neizčrpen vir tudi za sodobne raziskave slovenskega jezika, razvoj slovenskega zgodovinskega jezikoslovja, razvoj slovenske dialektologije, naglasoslovje slovenskega jezika, raziskovanje ravnin slovenskega jezika, imenoslovje, geolingvistiko in Ramovšev pomen pri ustanavljanju ljubljanske univerze in filozofske fakultete ter Ramovševe delo na SAZU. Znanstveno srečanje bo potekalo v okviru Ramovševega tedna. Recenzirani prispevki bodo objavljeni v Razpravah II. razreda SAZU. [Preberi več](#)

Ramovš week on the 70th anniversary of the death of one of the most important Slovenian linguists, academician prof. dr. Fran Ramovš, will take place at the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts, the Fran Ramovš Institute for the Slovene Language of ZRC SAZU and the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana **between September 20 and 23, 2022**. The following events will take place: Ramovs day: international meeting and day of the Fran Ramovš Institute of the Slovenian Language ZRC SAZU in the Atrium of ZRC SAZU and the Prešeren Hall of SAZU and the opening of the exhibition about Fran Ramovš at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana on Tuesday, September 20, 2022; Ramovš symposium in the Great Hall of SAZU on **September 21, 2022**; 4th Slovene Dialectological Conference (SDP 4) in the Prešeren Hall of the SAZU on September 22 and 23, 2022. The week will begin with the laying of a wreath on the renovated Ramovš grave in Plečnik Žale on **Friday, September 16, 2022**.

Ramovš Symposium

The Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts (Class II for Philological and Literary Sciences) is organizing a scientific symposium on Wednesday, September 21, 2022, on the 70th anniversary of the death of academician Fran Ramovš. Humanist, Slovene scholar, comparative linguist, language historian, dialectologist, nominologist, editor and university professor academician Fran Ramovš was born on September 14, 1890, in Ljubljana, where he died on September 16, 1952. After studying in Graz and Vienna, in 1919 he was one of the co-founders of the University of Ljubljana - on December 3 he gave the first lecture at the newly founded University of Ljubljana, between 1934 and 1935 he was rector of the university - and one of the first professors of the Faculty of Arts, also its dean between 1926 and 1927. He was a co-founder and one of the first appointed members of the Academy of Sciences and Arts in Ljubljana (1938), and later its chief secretary (1942–1950) and 4th president (1950–1952). In 1945, he founded and then headed the Institute for the Slovenian Language. He was an honorary member of the Slavic Society of Slovenia and a corresponding member of several academies of science. His scientific work is also an inexhaustible source for modern research into the Slovenian language. The symposium will present the importance of Ramovš's work for the history of the Slovenian language, the development of Slovenian historical linguistics, the development of Slovenian dialectology, the accentuation of the Slovenian language, research on the levels of the Slovenian language, nomenclature, geolinguistics, and Ramovš's importance in the founding of the University of Ljubljana and the Faculty of Philosophy, as well as Ramovš's work at SAZU. The scientific meeting will take place within the framework of Ramovš Week. Peer-reviewed papers will be published in Discussions of the II. SAZU class. [Read more](#)
